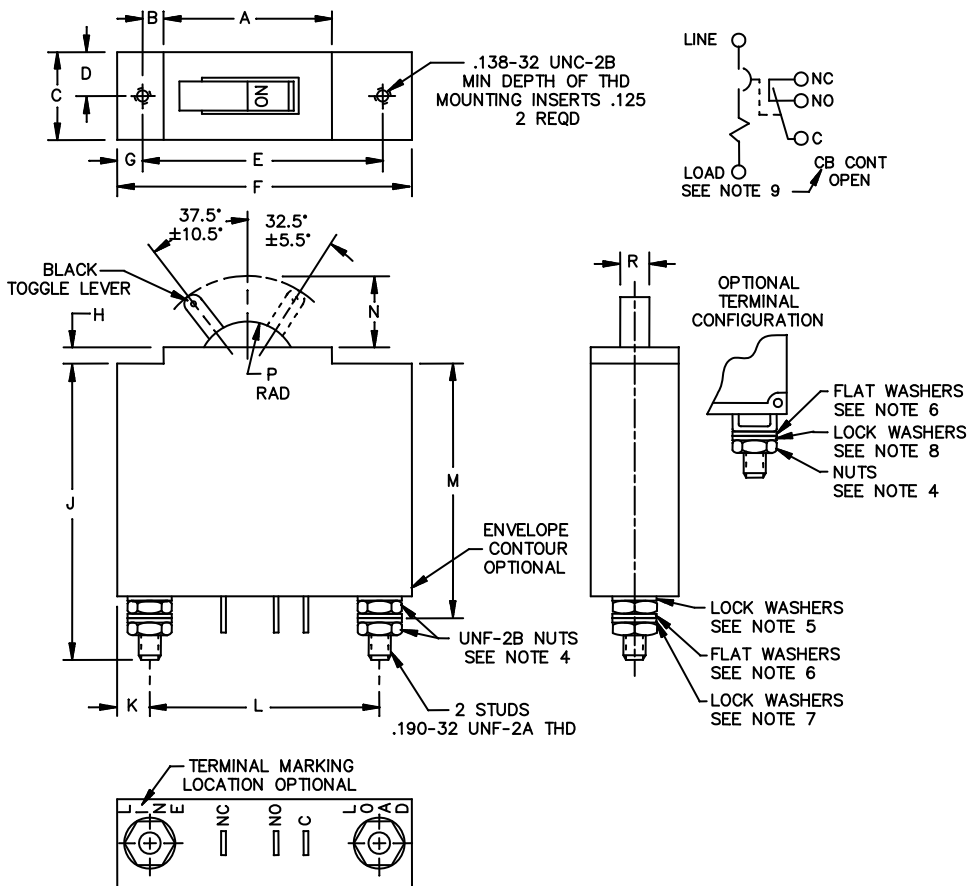


FIGURE 1. Dimensions and configurations (configuration 1).

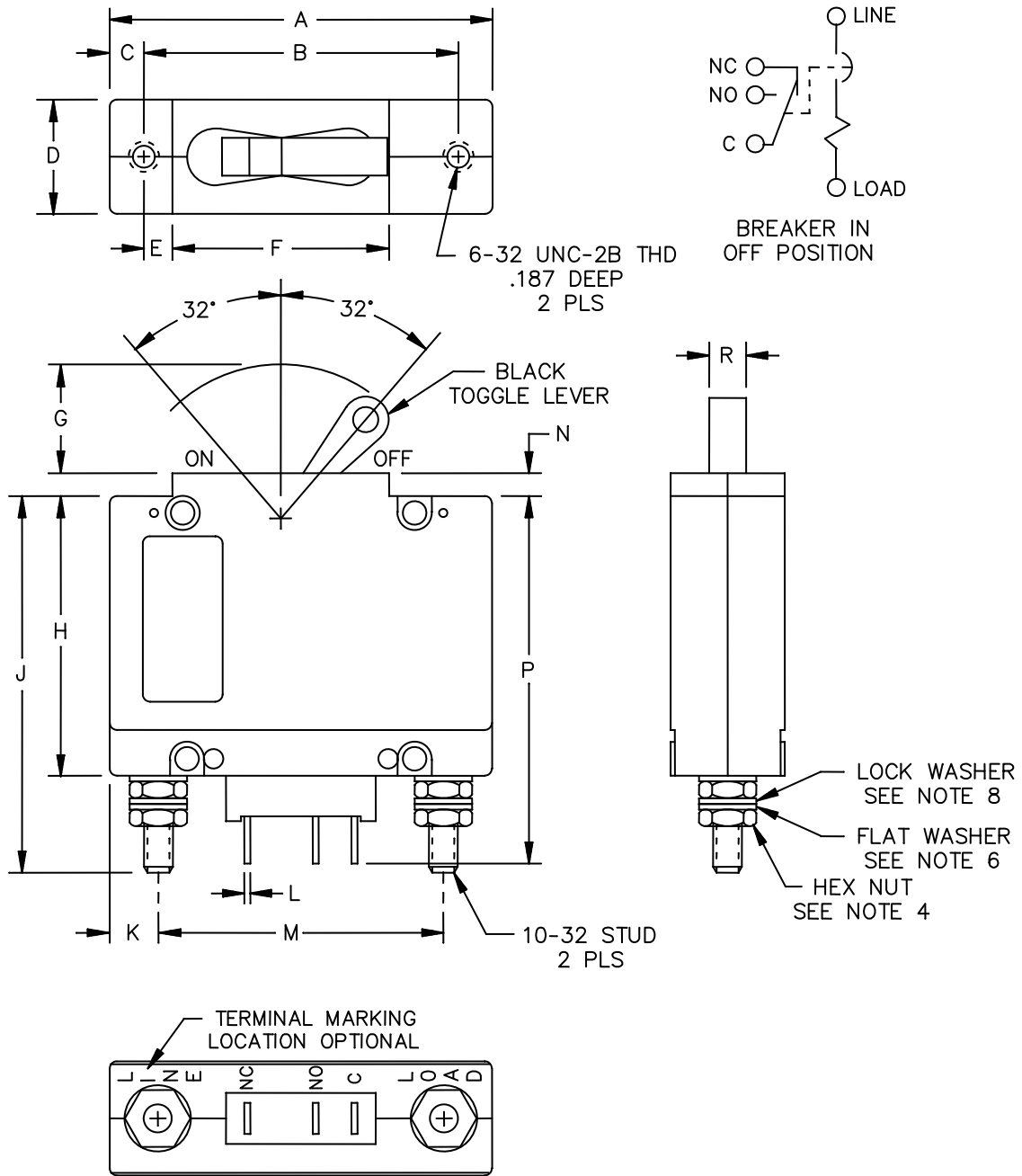


FIGURE 2. Dimensions and configurations (configuration 2).
